



**GROS 2014 SPRING SHOW
MEMBER SALES OF PLANTS**



- 1) All members are invited to sell surplus plants and orchid related items at the annual show.
 - a) Members entitled to participate in the sale of plants are paid up GROS members in good standing.
 - b) Members who are vendors at the show are not entitled to sell at the Member Sales Table
- 2) A sales table area for sales of member plants will be provided in the vendor area of the show. The amount of selling space available will be determined by the Show Chairman.
- 3) Plants must be established, clean and presentable, free of pests and diseases.
 - a) The member sales table chairman has the right to reject sales items from members that are deemed unsuitable for sale.
- 4) Plants for sale at the show should be dropped off on Thursday, March 29th between 10:00 am and 7:00 pm. If you need special arrangements, please contact Mike DeVito by phone (315-986-4563) or e-mail (mdevito1@rochester.rr.com). A space will be set aside away from the sales table to hold Sunday's plants.
- 5) A maximum of 15 plants per day per member will be eligible. A maximum of 30 plants for the two day show is allowed.
- 6) Apart from the plant name label, a second label provided by GROS, showing the seller's sales identification number, plant number and the price (which must be in multiples of 50 cents), is to be placed with each plant.
- 7) Each plant must be entered on an inventory sheet for each day
- 8) Upon sale, we will remove your name/numbered label from the pot and note its sale upon the inventory sheet so we can reimburse you in a timely manner.
- 9) All members utilizing the member's sales table are required to work a minimum of two hours at the show Saturday or Sunday. A schedule will be set up to indicate the actual time for each member.
- 10) Members working at the sales table are required to wear identification badges supplied by the sales table chairman, and should be prepared to answer questions, and promote sales.
- 11) The Society will provide a Cashier's box.
- 12) The Society will deduct a donation of 15% from the sale of plants. The Treasurer will be responsible for collection of the donation and sending remaining payment to members in a timely manner.
- 13) Unsold plants may be removed from the Sales Section prior to the termination of the show.
- 14) The Society or its agents will accept no responsibility for theft, destruction of plants, loss, or damage of any kind to plants submitted for sale. However, due care and diligence will be exercised to prevent the loss, theft and pilfering of all product left in the care of Shows' agents.
- 15) The submission of plants for sale will indicate acceptance by, and be conditional on the seller to be bound by these requirements.
