There's a real chance that it will stop snowing by the time our April meeting rolls around. It's entirely possible. Let's take the positive perspective, and look forward to Spring as we welcome a visitor from the East - our April speaker Ken Hull from the CNYOS, who will present "Wild Orchids of New York State."

A noted nature photographer, Ken has traveled extensively both in and outside of New York State in search of native orchids - and his amazing slides were taken in many mosquito-infested bogs and fens.

Mr. Hull is retired from the Micro Biology Lab at UHS Wilson Hospital Center in Johnson City, New York. His beautiful and well thought out

slide presentation features Lady Slipper orchids of the genus *Cypripedium*, members of the genus *Platanthera* (Fringed and Pad-leaved orchids, among others), and many other naturally occurring orchid species and hybrids found in the Empire State.

Some endangered species in NYS, such as the "Ram's Head" orchid, (*Cypripedium arietinum*) are very tiny. Many are found *only* by carefully scrutinizing their habitat. If you enjoy looking for pink lady slippers (*Cypripedium acaule*), Ken tells us they can be found at Chenango Valley State Park around Memorial Day. Additionally, if you want to understand the difference between a bog and a fen, well, this will be a good meeting to attend!

Since Ken will not be selling plants at the meeting, members are free to bring their own plants for sale or trade. We'll be taking Ken to dinner before the meeting at 5 p.m. at Tandoor of India, 376 Jefferson Road in Henrietta. As usual, everyone (except Ken...) pays for his or her own dinner. Please RSVP to Noel if you're planning to come. The Show Table will be back, so please don't forget to bring your flowering plants.

## Show Table Duties Change Hands

This column will look a little different under my authorship. I am following the practice of the RHS and listing the old names as synonyms. Many of these names are still in horticultural use by respected orchid suppliers. Carter and Holmes comes to mind.

Different growers have different perspectives on the renaming of many genera. We all know about the lumpers and the splitters. It seems for *Oncidium* and *Phalaenopsis*, the lumpers have the edge at the moment - *Odontoglossum* is now *Oncidium*, *Doritis* is now *Phalaenopsis*. On the other hand, the *Masdevallias* have been split into three. The new generic names are supposed to be based on DNA and more reliable than groupings based on morphology alone. That sounds great in theory, but I dimly recall a letter to the AOS magazine arguing that the section of the genome sampled for the realignment of many genera is too narrow for validity. Having no training in genetics, I cannot speak to that, but the cynic in me says someone else will come along who needs a PhD thesis and will redo everything.

Until the dust settles, if I want to look up the background of a particular cross, the RHS search engine uses the new names. If I want an award, or if I make a new cross and want to register it, I need to use the new name. If I want to purchase the pretty/interesting/cool looking plant I admired at a show table, I might find it under the old name or the new name. If I want to be able to pronounce the name, I'll take *Howeara* over *Leomesezia* any day.

New names below are in boldface, spelling or capitalization changes in italics. Correct abbreviation for correct genus name is in parentheses immediately after the first appearance of the name.

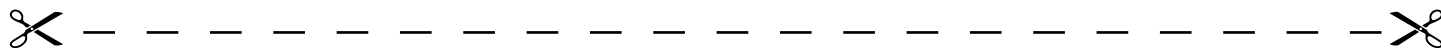
