Publicity - flyers: Help to plan, create and facilitate the distribution of posters and flyers to appropriate local businesses.

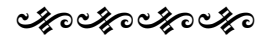
Publicity - free: Facilitate editorial content related to orchids and our members in local publications. Contact various publications in our area and provide them with contacts and story ideas.

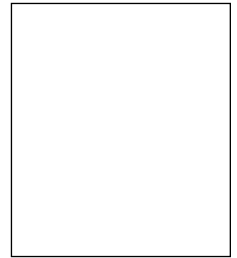
