 (Note: In some cases where a natural hybrid was published, and the same hybrid in cultivation was published under a different name, both names are legitimate. When exhibited in a show, the cultivated name is usually preferred. The above cultivated name is to distinguish the hybrid from the species *C. schilleriana* [1857].)

(Note: Contact Lamberton & copy everything from their label. It will increase the value of your plant. Both divisions must have the same clone name. If there is no label, wait until your division blooms, then if it seems to be a species, check it against the Internet Orchid Species Photo Encyclopedia. <http://www.orchidspecies.com> Send a contribution; it is a labor of love. If you can't find your plant there, send a picture to Fred Clarke. <http://www.sunsetvalleyorchids.com>)

I hope the auction buyers find this helpful. It includes parents of registered hybrids, and registered grexes where only the parents were listed. Notice especially the updated genus names. Any auction plants not on this list were assumed to be correct. Having your orchid correctly labeled will help you to:

- Find additional information on the Internet and in publications.
- Be more informative to others on the show table.
- Enable you to enter your plant in the correct class in a show - a misclassified plant might not be judged.
- Enable you to breed with it if you are so inclined.
- Increase your plant's value.

Please note: the genera *Sophronitis*, *Odontoglossum*, Brazilian *Laelia*, *Ascocentrum*, and *Neofinetia* **DO NOT EXIST**.
