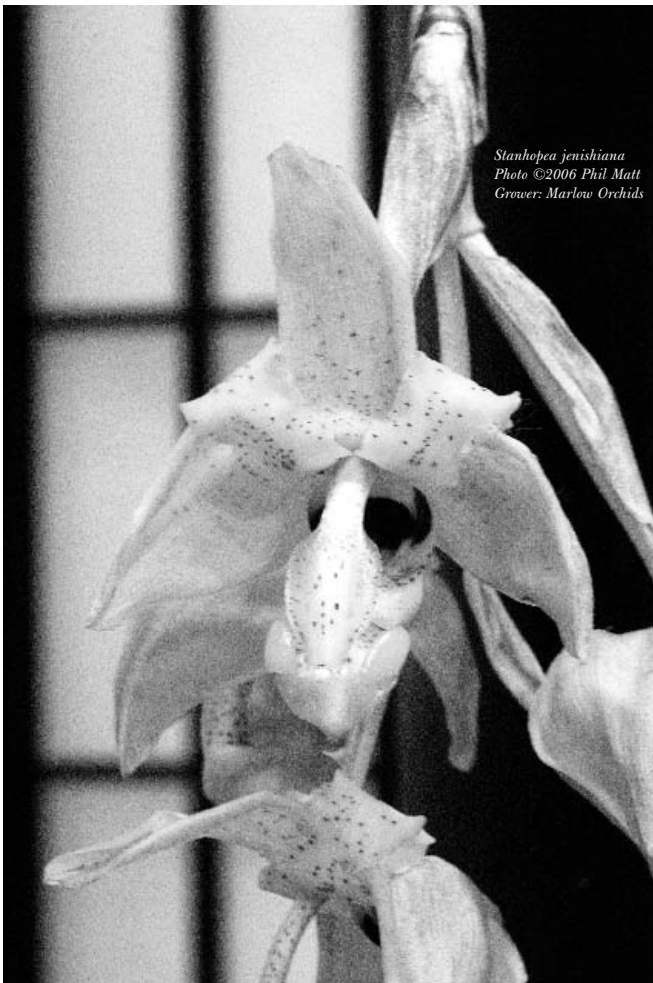

Come and join your orchid friends for a fascinating evening in May as we welcome Linda Wilhelm of Woodland Orchids. Linda will present a program on *Stanhopeas*.

The "Bucket Orchids," *Stanhopeas* range in tropical America from Mexico through Brazil. They have very complex, short-lived flowers, which are pollinated by Euglossine bees attracted to their very heady fragrance. The flowers, produced on pendant spikes extending downward from the plant, are among the most unusual in the orchid kingdom.

Linda has been growing orchids longer than she cares to remember. Her hobby started out small before she met Rolf (both husband and business partner.) Eventually out of this "hobby" sprang Woodland Orchids, a business since 1989. Linda is an accredited judge for the American Orchid Society, Chair of the Carolinas Judging Center in Greensboro, NC and a recipient of the AOS's Certificate of Education. She will be bringing plants for sale and is offering a discount for a 'group' order dependent on the amount of the order. Her web site is at woodlandorchids.com. 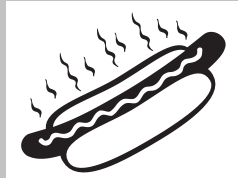
