Join us at our last "formal" meeting before the GROS picnic in June, as our own Program Vice President Jim Marlow presents "Growing Award Winning Orchids." Jim's talk will focus on an overview of three distinctly different orchid groups: mini Cymbidiums, Paphiopedilum parvisepalum hybrids, and Lycastes - with many expert tips on culture.

Jim is the proprietor of Marlow Orchids in nearby Scottsville, NY - one of New York State's leading commercial orchid growers. Anyone who has visited Marlow's is well aware of the diversity and quality of the plants in the greenhouse. The fact that an excursion to Jim's has long been a planned activity for many regional orchid societies is a testament not only to the exceptional orchids found there, but also to the hospitality and expertise of the owner.

Mr. Marlow has been growing orchids for more than thirty years; his presentation will include the "tricks and secrets" of getting orchids to rebloom in the Northeast US seasonal climates. Marlow's Orchids has been an exhibitor and vendor at the GROS shows for many, many years. Jim has won countless awards for both his orchids and for the quality of his show displays. He currently exhibits and sells at many orchid shows throughout the Northeast, and is a familiar face at many orchid societies where he has spoken on a variety of orchid topics. Recently, Jim and Marlow Orchids were featured in a long article in the Rochester Democrat & Chronicle newspaper.

We will be taking Jim to dinner at 5:15 p.m. (before the meeting) at Mamasan's Noodle Caboodle, 2800 Monroe Avenue; if you'd like to join us, (everyone pays for his or her own dinner) please call our Program VP - it's Jim! - at 585-889-7983 to make sure that there will be enough space.

GROS Makes Plans For Donations

May is traditionally the month in which we vote to make our annual donations. Below is a suggested list for this year, a total of \$1,200. These donations are part of the object of our Society, as defined in our bylaws: "...to stimulate interest in orchids and educate members and the public in their culture, improvement, use and conservation."

Last year we also gave \$100 to Jacob Phelps for conservation. He had spoken to us on his travels in Southeast Asia and orchid conservation. I do not know what he is doing now, so left that donation off the list.

The donation to Sonnenberg Gardens has at times been controversial. I think they are now owned by New York State. Also there was some concern whether the money we gave was actually being used for their orchids. Last year we gave the donation with the stipulation that it was for materials only, presumably for the purchase of potting supplies.

Another question is whether the money donated to the Lamberton Horticultural Trust Fund really goes to the orchid collection. We may want to donate repotting materials or other supplies specific to orchids.

I do not know at this time if we made money at the show this year or not. If our treasury is down considerably, we may need to cut back on some of these donations. Here is the list:
