Our speaker for May will be Inge Poot, from Ontario, Canada. Inge will discuss "Stanhopeas." A genus commonly known as the "Bucket Orchids," Stanhopeas are mostly epiphytic in habit. They have short-lived, large, waxy flowers (which look a bit like buckets) that hang out of the bottoms of their pots. They are also commonly grown in baskets. Stanhopeas are native to Central and South America; there are more than 90 species described, with about 100 hybrids (not counting intergenerics) currently having been registered.

Inge has been growing orchids since she and her husband Peter were married over 45 years ago. They have been active members of the Southern Ontario Orchid Society since that time and have both held jobs such as president and show chairman and directors, in between. Both Inge and Peter are both accredited judges of the American Orchid Society and in that capacity do a lot of traveling in the Spring and Fall.

We will be taking Inge and Peter out to dinner on April 12th, prior to the meeting. If you'd like to join us (everyone pays for his or

## Meeting Minutes for April 12, 2010

In the absence due to illness of President **Paul Batz**, Vice-President **Kim Hober** called the meeting to order at 7:10 p.m. Kim welcomed members and guests. She congratulated everyone on the successful show this past weekend. **Len Bayer** was invited to give his report on attendance at the show. Attendees totaled 1,271 for 2010, the average from past years being 1,600. Len attributed the smaller number due to the increased ticket price as well as nice weather. Financially, we took in approximately \$9,200 total. \$7,980 was in paid admissions, \$550 in new & renewed memberships and \$675 in merchandise. Coupon redemption was about 73%.

Show Chairlady **Ruth Espinosa-Barone** talked about the Show. She said that no negative comments were made on the increase in cost of admission. Special thanks go to everyone who worked so hard to make it a good show:

Thanks also to all the other members who volunteered for different things such as helping carry in plants from vehicles. Checks will be in the mail soon to members who sold plants. Thanks to everyone who brought in food for the weekend. Leftover orchid books and posters are available for sale at this meeting.

**Ron Uhlig**, treasurer, gave some totals from the show also. Income was \$14,100 (\$1,000 more than last year), expenses were \$9,400 (\$3,000 less than last year) bringing a profit of \$4,000. This is our major society fundraiser.

A motion was made by **Diane Bernard** to accept the March meeting minutes. A second by **Barb Greene** was followed by a unanimous vote. The March minutes were accepted.

Treasurer **Ron Uhlig** gave us the details of our financial state for the past month. His report

will be in the May newsletter. One comment on income is notable: we would like to give special thanks to our President Paul Batz, who recently spoke to a garden club and donated his speaker's fee to the GROS.

The expense report was accepted.

Per the rules in the ByLaws, Member at Large, **Alan Salzman**, presented the slate of officers for next year (2010-2011):

After the raffle, the show table was presented by **Jeanne Kaeding**, assisted by **Kim Hober**.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:00 p.m.

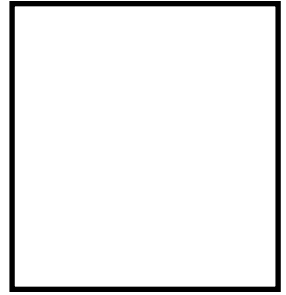
