



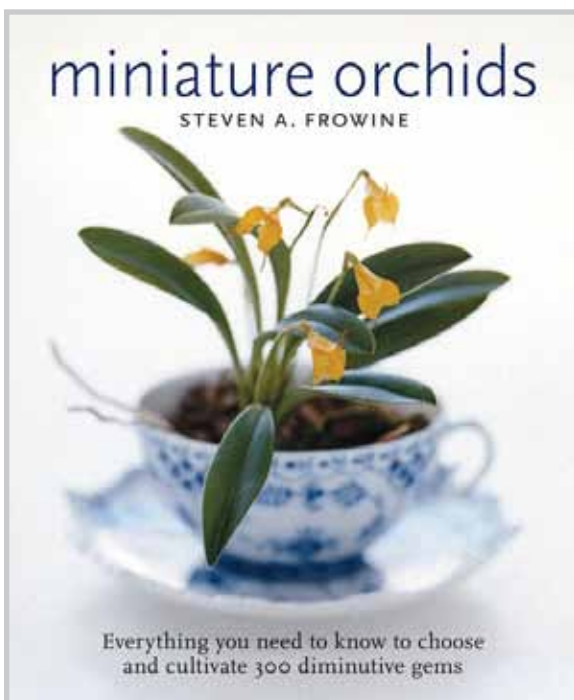

**I**s your orchid collection getting too big for your home? Did you get caught trying to sneak that four-foot *Grammatophyllum speciosum* "seedling" into the house under your coat? Fear not! Horticulturist, noted garden writer and speaker Steve Frowine will visit us in May to provide some guidance with ideas about "Miniature Orchids" - to fill in the "extra spaces" in our collections, and to prove once again that there's always room for another (smaller) orchid!

**S**teve, an avid gardener, is interested in many facets of horticulture and has a special love for orchids and other tropical plants. He has written over 200 articles for such publications as *Fine Gardening Magazine*, *American Nurseryman*, *Nursery Business*, *National Gardening*, and *Country Woman Magazine*. He is the author of four books on orchids: "Orchids for Dummies," "Fragrant Orchids," "Miniature Orchids," and "Moth Orchids." Steve also did most of the photography for these books - which will be available for purchase at the May meeting.

Mr. Frowine has served as Supervisor of Education at Pacific Tropical Botanical Garden in Hawaii, Editor and Activities Coordinator at The Garden Center of Greater Cleveland, Director of the Pittsburgh Civic Garden Center in Mellon Park, and Chairman of Indoor Horticulture at Missouri Botanical Garden. He was Public Relations Manager and Staff Horticulturist for W. Atlee Burpee & Company, and was Vice-President of horticulture at White Flower Farm.

During his career Steve has been a Board Member of The American Association of Botanical Gardens and Garden Writers of America, has served as a judge at many of the major US flower shows, and was Chairman of the Board of The National Gardening Association. He gives horticultural talks throughout the U.S. and has appeared on Martha Stewart Living, the Home Shopping Network, and HGTV. Steve has been an active orchid grower for over forty years, with a collection of hundreds of orchids in his home.

The speaker will not be selling orchids at the meeting, so orchid sales by members will be allowed. Watch the GROS website for dinner plans with Steve the evening of the meeting.

## Meeting Minutes for Monday, April 4, 2011

Kathy was a long time active member who had welcomed new members and supported all the Society events with such enthusiasm. It seems that many of the members have memories of working with her. Kathy will be greatly missed.

A motion was made by **Len Bayer** to accept the March meeting minutes. A second was made by **Jeanne Kaeding**, a vote was taken and the minutes were accepted.

Refreshments were provided this evening by **Denise Milanette** and **Diane Bernard**.

**Ron Uhlig**, treasurer, gave the financial report for the past month. A motion was made by Jeanne Kaeding, seconded by **Josh Hollander**, a vote was taken and the report was accepted.

**Ron Uhlig**, show chairman, gave a brief report on the show. He will have a detailed report at the May meeting. After the raffle, the show table was presented by **Claudio Rossi**.

I was told that it is not a problem with the product but a problem with the way the distributor stores the product before it is put out for sale. It cannot be frozen, hence the problem. I called the nursery from which I purchased 5 bottles and they admitted that they did not know that it couldn't be stored in an unheated warehouse.

I have had no more problem with the new bottles that I have purchased. I usually get them from Lowe's and they store them correctly and the product is available all year round. Hope this helps!

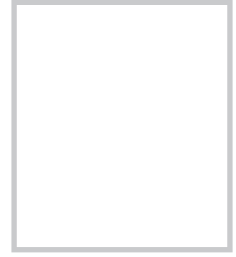
