The Show season is over, and the Summer season is just coming into view. Despite the ups-and-downs of the thermometer, Spring is imminent, more or less.

Take a break from your gardening work and join us in May as Gary Meyer of Hawkhill Orchids in Pacifica, California presents “Dracuphilia: A Gothic Romance.” Dr. Meyer’s interest in orchids began when he was a freshman in high school in Michigan. He started growing Draculas in his parents’ basement in 1990, with some degree of success. However, college, then medi-

cal school, and finally graduate school became unavoidable “distractions” for him. He now has two overcrowded greenhouses in his San Francisco backyard, populated by several hundred Dracula plants (along with a reasonable dose of Masdevallias, Lepanthes, Cyrtorchilums, and Anguloas.)

Gary has been travelling to Colombia and Ecuador once or twice a year since 2005 to observe Draculas in the wild and to visit collections of South American Dracula growers. By day, he is a Research Manager at IntrinsicQ, LLC, where he tracks the oncology pharmaceutical industry. He is the owner of Colombian Orchid Imports, which imports orchid species from Colombia for sale in the United States, and also runs marketing and sales for Hawk Hill Orchids of Pacifica, California.

Gary will accept pre-orders for plants on the Hawk Hill Orchids website until April 29, 2012. There will be no charges for shipping, as Gary will deliver your plants at the meeting. We’re taking Gary out to diner at Pomodoro’s Restaurant, 1290 University Ave, Rochester directly before the meeting at 5:00 p.m. sharp (everyone pays his or her own way.) Members can contact Program Chairwoman Carol Butcher if they plan to attend; all are welcome.

**Dave Weiss** was contacted by someone who would like to buy orchids from someone who is downsizing their orchid collection. If you are interested, contact Dave Weiss.

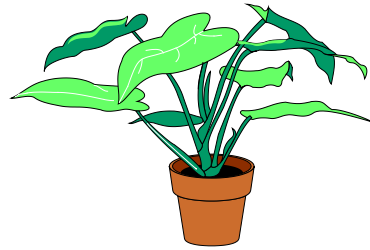

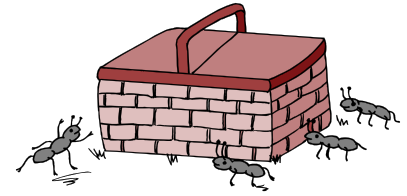
