

After a fairly scorching Summer season that faded away in a hot, soggy transition, it finally feels more or less like we’ve crossed over into early Fall.

The new orchid season begins with a visit from Jason Fischer, who comes to us from Orchids Limited in Plymouth, Minnesota, where he runs the nursery with his father, Jerry Fischer. (Jerry was last here in November of 1996, when he spoke on “Orchid Adventures in Borneo.”) Jason’s topic for our meeting will be “Phragmipedium Breeding.”

Orchids Limited is a mid-sized operation of 4 greenhouses with 15,000 square feet of growing space, including a shade house and laboratory. Jason has had a life-long education in orchids; having worked for his father since the age of 5, Jason has learned the orchid world from both the business and hobbyist perspectives. He took interest in orchid hybridization and lab work around 14 years of age, and first started breeding with *Phalaenopsis*, which later on

lead him to work with *Paphs*, *Phrags* and other miscellaneous hybrids. The *Phragmipedium* hybrid that bears his name, *Phragmipedium* Jason Fischer, was registered by Orchids Limited in 1996. It has received more American Orchid Society FCC’s to date than any other *Phragmipedium* hybrid. *Phrag.* Jason Fischer is a hybrid between the species *Phrag. besseae* and *Phrag. Memoria Dick Clements*.

Jason will be bringing plants for sale; however, with such a large catalog of available and high quality plants, it is recommended that you pre-order for plants you know you want. You can pre-order on the Orchid Limited website, indicating “Genesee Region Orchid Society trip” in the special instructions field. A 10% discount will be available for pre orders and you do not have to pay for shipping. The deadline for pre-orders is September 7th.

The Show Table will be back, so please don’t forget your flowering plants. Plans for taking Jason to dinner prior to the meeting are still in the works - please check the website for late-breaking news. We’ll see you there!

We want you! We need you! Don't delay! - you can start planning the GROS 2012 Show immediately!


GROS Members to Choose Picnic Date at Sept. Meeting

advance to guarantee the availability of a picnic shelter at the park where the picnic will be held.



