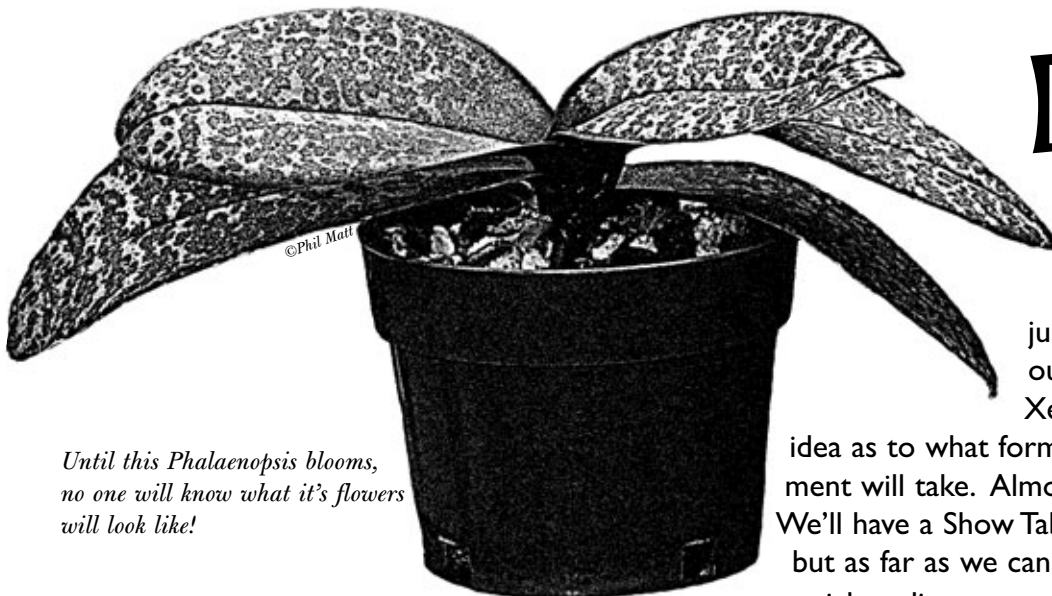

## Show Chairwoman Offers Thanks for Jobs Well Done!

Speaking as Show Chairperson for the 2007 Spring Show and Sale, I would like to give you a quick update. Attendance at our show on a very rainy Saturday and a rather cloudy Sunday showed an attendance of 805 on Saturday and 673 on Sunday, totaling 1,478 people joining us in our annual activities. This is fewer people than attended in 2006 but more than in 2005. In addition there were 46 new memberships issued. I would like to welcome all of the new members and hope that they enjoy their experiences with the GROS. Further details of expenses and income will be available soon from the club Treasurer.

Many people volunteered their time and efforts to the successful venue of our show. We attempted a new experiment with the society exhibit this year. We broke up the customary single large club exhibit into four smaller separate exhibits. This worked well for the most part and will need some fine tuning if we decide to continue this concept in the future. The Awards Banquet was held at the Museum this year and it proved to be a convenient and popular event.

## Meeting Minutes for April 9, 2007

President **Randy Humphries** called the meeting to order at 7:15 p.m.

Approximately 10 new members were introduced and welcomed into the GROS. **Margery Greene** gave the treasurer's report and the current balance is \$15,308.47. **Kathy Kluge** gave a report on our annual orchid show. She first thanked everyone who worked on the committee and then gave us some highlights from the show.

Attendance was down slightly from last year but up from 2 years ago. On Saturday, attendance was 805 and on Sunday, it was 673 for a total of 1478 paid admittance. 46 new members joined our society at the show.

Guest speaker, Dr. Glenn Lehr, was introduced by **Diane Bernard**. Dr. Lehr specializes in Japanese orchids, having attended many conferences in Japan and traveling extensively in that country. His slide presentation dealt with the Japanese shows and their beautiful exhibits with special emphasis on Fu-Ran, the wind orchid, better known to us as *Neofinetia falcata*. Dr. Lehr showed slides of the many colors and forms of this plant and had many types for sale to the members.

The show table was presented by Randy Humphries and **Joe Kunish**. The meeting was adjourned at approximately 8:50 p.m.
