Meeting Minutes Sept. 8, 2003

Jeanne Kaeding called the September 2003 meeting to order at 7:15. She began by acknowledging the new members. She also thanked **Jackie Cannizarro** for the wonderful refreshments provided by her committee. Jeanne reminded the membership that our next meeting would be the GROS Auction on October 12.

Jeanne introduced **Marilyn Menegus** as chairperson for the Beginners Meeting. **Ron and Sandy Uhlig** were also introduced as the 2004 GROS show chairs. Ron requested that all members consider helping with the show. Jeanne announced that we are still in need of a chairperson to organize the annual GROS picnic. She also reported that we are looking for an associate librarian. **Dean and Carolyn Edwards** have nurtured and cared for our library for many years. They are now ready to turn over the reins and would like to begin mentoring an associate.

Phil Matt requested that any member interested in writing an article for the newsletter, please contact him. He encouraged members to think about different topics and to consider contributing. Also, a general discussion centered on the possibility of an electronic newsletter. This could possibly reduce costs since the newsletter is one of our larger expenditures.

Randy Humphries requested a show of hands of members who also maintained membership in the AOS. He announced that he would provide brochures for those who wish to join. **Judy Ekberg** is chairing a committee discuss and edit the GROS by-laws. Some of the articles are vague and unclear.

Jeanne Kaeding explained the issue of changing our judging center affiliation. Reasons for changing include historically good representation from the Toronto Center, a decrease in conflicts with our show date, and the probability of having more judges at our annual show. After some discussion, **Len Bayer** moved to change our affiliation to Toronto. **Constance Anglin** seconded that motion. A majority of membership agreed.

The 2003-2004 budget was published in the newsletter and Jeanne initiated a discussion. Len Bayer moved to accept the budget as presented and Constance Anglin seconded. Membership voted to accept the budget.

The issue of adopting non-profit status was again brought to the floor. Jeanne reported that she discussed this issue with a lawyer who stated that technically GROS is a non-profit organization. Len stated that the organization has pursued this topic before and it did not seem cost effective to pursue designation as a 5013 C. In addition, it would mean a considerable amount of yearly paperwork. However, without this designation, donations to GROS are not tax deductible. It was agreed that we needed to form a committee to further research this topic and make recommendations.

Steve McCarroll reported that the annual audit was within \$2.00. The complete audit will be published in the newsletter. **Judy Ekberg** provided a treasurer's report of \$13,071.51.

Lena Parker, an accredited AOS judge for more than 20 years and a member of the Board of Directors of AOS, came to us from Shreveport, Louisiana and presented a slide program on "Orchids of Cost Rica". **Mark Gillette** presented the show table. The meeting ended at approximately 9:30 p.m.

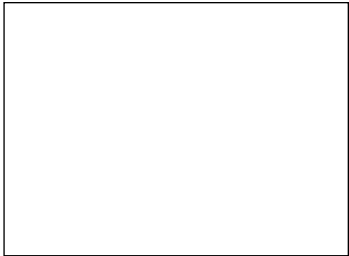
