Linda will give us an idea of what Miltonias really are after all the nomenclature changes of recent years. Linda and her husband have been growing and hybridizing orchids for many years. When first starting, the Wilhelms specialized in breeding warm-

tolerant *Oncidiinae*, but as is often the case, their interest changed and now their main breeding efforts are in the miniature and compact cattleya hybrids. They also breed a number of different species and have made some wonderful Stanhopea hybrids.

As an Accredited Judge with the AOS, Linda is very active in the judging program. She enjoys being involved in shows outside her region, including offshore shows in Central America and the islands. She is a frequent guest speaker at orchid societies all over the USA as well as having lectured in Brazil, Trinidad, Barbados and Guatemala.

Linda will be bringing plants for sale; however, with such a large catalog of high quality plants, she recommends that you pre-order for the plants that you know you want. Jeanne advised that the nominating committee, Kate Recard, chairman, Margery Green and Jen Lang, has put together a slate of officers for presentation at the annual meeting. President – Jeanne Kaeding, Vice President – Natalie Auburn, Program Chair – Kim Hober, Secretary-Margery Greene and Treasurer – Denis Monefeldt. The floor will be open for other nominations to the above offices, and the Member At Large prior to the vote at the May meeting.

Show Report

Jeanne thanked Diane Bernard and Carol Butcher for their chairmanship and job well done. She also announced that Jonathan Jones has offered to serve as show chairman next year and asked that everyone give him all the support he needs going forward. Jeanne further thanked all those that volunteered, moved vendors in and out, brought food and helped out in many other ways.

Diane confirmed that attendance was down by 50. There were 754 paid attendees this year as opposed to 794 in 2016. She thanked everyone for their help and mentioned that Sue Ackerman's Orchid-gami display received rave reviews.

Diane thanked our 'On-Air' personalities, Bill Renick, Kim Hober and Fran Murphy for their radio and television spots. She had a special thanks to Carol Butcher's son for fixing the flat tire on Diane's van during show take-down.

Denis Monefeldt reported the following for the show:

The above does not include vendor fees and member table commissions. Expenses have yet to be finalized, please get them in as soon as possible.

Jeanne thanked Phil for his work on the member's sale table. The numbers were fairly typical with gross sales of \$1,636. Commissions to GROS would be \$245.40. Sales tax collected was about \$130. Some discussion followed on collection of sales tax. Thanks to Fran Murphy for all the Cattleyas he brought to sell.

There were fifteen plants pulled for AOS judging and five were awarded. They were:

- HCC of 77 pts to Paph. Pedro's Moon 'Haley Suzanne', grown by Glen Decker of Piping Rock Orchids
- HCC of 77pts to C. Mini Apricot 'Brighton Red', grown by Allan Sowinski
- HCC of 77pts to *Paph. rothschildianum* 'Brighton Rogue', again grown by Allan Sowinski. Allan is an amateur grower and a long time member of our society.

show on Orchid virus and Jeanne Kaeding demonstrated the use of a virus testing kit. Agdia, Inc. donated the kit for GROS members to experiment with. A number of members tested several plants and positive results were obtained for some of the plants. Kim advised the group that another option to self-testing are services such as Critter Creek where a piece of leaf is mailed in and analyzed for virus and results reported back.

Susan Whitney supervised the raffle.

Phil Matt and Margery Greene presented the show table.

11 New Orchid Species Found in Sabah

Eleven previously unknown orchid species have recently been found in Sabah, a state on the northern part of the island of Borneo, which is part of Malaysia. The species were found in different locations in Sabah, including inside Kinabalu Park. Kinabalu Park is familiar to many orchidists as one of the last remaining habitats of several rare Paphiopedilum orchid species.

The new species, which are from the Dipodium family, were described and reported in the Malesian Orchid Journal published by naturalist C.L. Chan. The new species were described by Peter O' Byrne, a world authority on Borneo orchids, during his ongoing research.

According to Wikipedia, "Dipodium is a genus of about 25 species of orchids native to tropical, subtropical and temperate regions of southeast Asia, New Guinea, the Pacific Islands and Australia. It is the only genus of its alliance, Dipodium. Plants of this genus are commonly referred to as hyacinth orchids."

A bit of visual research shows these to be tall terrestrial orchids bearing primarily pink/red and white/red-speckled flowers. There doesn't seem to be much, if any, cultivation by orchid hobbyists.

"One of the new species, *Dipodium chanii*, was named after Chan himself while another, *Dipodium lambii*, was named after Datuk Anthony Lamb.

Lamb, a British botanist, began working in Sabah 54 years ago and was instrumental in

setting up the renowned Tenom Agriculture Centre," according to an article published on Sunday, April 16, 2017 by The Star Online, a website run by the Star Media Group, Berhad, Malaysia.
