GROS Meeting Minutes - Mar. 5, 2018

GROS Meeting Minutes March 5, 2018

President Jeanne Kaeding called the meeting to order at 7:13 p.m.

Thanks to all who brought refreshments: Kate Recard, Carol Butcher, Luda & David Weiss

Welcome new member Kay Dennis.

There being no corrections to the minutes of the February 5, 2018 meeting, Phil Matt moved to accept, John Kellas seconded, and the minutes were accepted.

Treasurer Denis Monefeldt reported balances as of February 4, 2018:

Cash on hand as of 3/4/18: \$19,928.79

Included in above:

Income since last meeting: \$ 427.52

Expenses paid out: \$ 1,514.82

We got a request via our website for a speaker for the Country Gardeners of Webster for April 2019, on the 2nd Monday at 7 pm. David Weiss volunteered to do it or make sure someone does it. Phil Matt suggested to verify whether the request is for 2018 or 2019.

Jeanne announced thanks to Noel Krzesinski for her work on the Dutch Connection exhibit at the Eastman.

Jeanne also announced the nominating committee: Kate Recard, Denis Monefeldt and Margery Greene. The slate for next year's officers will be announced at the April meeting. Member-at-large will be nominated from the floor at the May meeting. Vote for all officers will be at the May meeting.

Jonathan Jones reported on Gardenscape and our show. Gardenscape setup will be Wednesday, March 7. The show is open Thursday through Sunday. We will have 2 free passes which volunteers can exchange as they come off shift. The passes for the first shift will be at the front desk at the Dome Center, which is also where the last shift should leave the passes.

Our spot is next to Marlow's Orchids. Anyone with plants to display can get them to Jeanne by Tuesday evening or bring them to the Dome

Center between 10 & 11 a.m. Wednesday.

The show is coming along. We need more volunteers to put up flyers. Also need volunteers to bring a dish to pass to feed the vendors and show aides. Jonathan also talked about the preview party with awards ceremony, food, drinks and cash bar. Sue Ackerman has the tickets available or order from the form on our website. Checks can be mailed to the GROS post office box. We have contracted for 50 people. We need to give the caterer the final count 6 days ahead.

Jonathan spoke about members entering exhibits, either their own or putting plants in the GROS exhibit, and also photography, artwork or needlework with an orchid theme.

More volunteers are needed for admissions and hosting.

Jonathan noted Bergen Swamp Society will be participating this year.

Jonathan initiated a discussion of planned layout including using the ballroom as classroom space, using the palm room, front area and hallway for art. Reaction included discussion of whether there would be a problem with security if the exhibit and sales areas were more open, and discussion of placement of backdrops. The ultimate layout is up to Jonathan as show chair.

Set-up crew is needed at 9:00 a.m. Thursday, March 22. Clerks should arrive by 9:00 a.m. Friday, March 23. Clerks are responsible for their own lunch. The judges will be taken to a restaurant lunch.

Phil Matt had member sales table forms available for those with plants they want to show.

Reminder, the show is open 2-5 p.m. Friday, March 23, with the preview party at 5:30 p.m.

Other business: Constance Anglin brought bromeliad divisions, free for the taking.

There being no further business, Jonathan Jones moved to adjourn, Emilie Monefeldt seconded, and the business part of our meeting was adjourned at 7:48 p.m.

Kim Hober introduced our speaker, Donna Lipowicz, who is an AOS judge and President of the Niagara Frontier Orchid Society. Donna gave a presentation on her recent trip to the World Orchid Conference in Guayaquil,

Ecuador, with a trip to the Galapagos Islands preceding the WOC.

There was no raffle this month.

Show table had only 3 plants – perhaps people are saving all their blooming plants for Gardenscape or our show?
