As we charge enthusiastically into Spring, our last formal meeting of the season (except for the Picnic, of course, which isn't formal at all...) will feature Gary Meyer, Ph.D, who will present “Dracuphilia: A Gothic Romance”. Gary will cover the history of the genus *Dracula*, the distribution of species, concepts in taxonomy and biology, and Gary's orchid explorations in the wild. The talk will additionally delve into the often conflicting effects of human interest on orchid conservation.

Gary Meyer's interest in orchids began when he was a freshman in high school in Michigan. Among his perennial garden plant collection were several *Cypripedium* species, which ignited

his curiosity about orchids from other parts of the globe. He now maintains several hundred *Dracula* plants (along with a reasonable dose *Masdevallias*, *Lepanthes*, *Cyrtorchilums*, and *Anguloas*) in his greenhouse in Pacifica, CA.

Gary has been travelling to Colombia and Ecuador since 2005 to observe *Draculas* in the wild and to visit collections of South American *Dracula* growers. He lives two to three months per year in Medellin, Colombia to facilitate his field explorations. Gary also put his scientific background to work on *Dracula* by studying the molecular taxonomy of the genus with Ken Cameron, Ph.D., director of the herbarium at the University of Wisconsin, and continues to describe new species and relocate lost species in conjunction with his South American colleagues.

By day, Gary is the Director of Clinical Analytics at IntrinsicQ Specialty Solutions. He is currently President of the Pleurothallid Alliance and owner of Colombian Orchid Imports, which imports orchid species from Colombia for sale in the United States.

Since Gary will *not* be bringing plants to sell, members are free to bring their own orchids for sale or trade at the May meeting. We will be taking Gary out to dinner before the meeting – plans are not yet complete: check the website for updates.

The Show Table will be back, so please remember to bring your flowering plants. We'll see you there!

GROS Meeting for April 8, 2019

Jonathan Jones started the meeting at 7:19 pm by welcoming several newcomers.

Bill Renick confirmed there will be a beginners' meeting next month.

Jonathan announced that name tags for new members & people who renewed at the show will be ready for next month's meeting.

Old business –Jeanne motioned to approve the minutes of the March, 2019 meetings, Bill Renick seconded, and the motion was passed.

For anyone who didn't see the newsletter – the email file is still being updated for sending out the link to the newsletter.

GROS show: attendance was up 168 from last year, best since 2012. The repotting table brought in over \$200 income cash plus whatever was paid by credit cards – approximately \$40.

Member sales table – Phil Matt reported gross sales of \$2,215.00 with \$1,636.25 to members and \$488.75 to the club. The sales tax is included in the gross amount. 135 plants were sold by 10 members. Thanks to all who worked the table.

Jonathan thanked all the show volunteers. We have already reserved next year's show date for the last weekend in March. We will keep to that date except in 2021 when Easter falls that final March weekend.

Jonathan requested members think about annual donations, which will be decided in May. Last year besides the Judging Center, we donated to Bergen Swamp, the Orchid Conservation Alliance, the Smithsonian affiliate that was the source of the Orchidgami. We sold three times as many Orchidgami at this year's show compared to last year.

Nominating Committee Chair person John Kellas announced the slate of officers for next year, to be voted on next meeting. The Nominating Committee included John Kellas, Jeanne Kaeding and Abigail McNinch. The slate is as follows:

With the exception of President, all nominees are the current office holders. Any additional nominations including nominee for Member-at-Large will be taken at the May meeting before the vote.

While Jonathan Jones will not be President next year, he will be Show Chairperson.

Bob Pfromm announced that various personal property left at the show could be claimed at the back table.

Jonathan did speak with Lamberton and they are interested in our help to report their orchids. Jonathan will take charge of this project, and Marlow Orchids will donate some specimen plants.

Marlow Orchids is having an Open House Saturday April 13 from 9:30 am to 4 pm.

Sonnenberg's Orchid Show is Friday through Sunday, April 12-14.

Although attendance at our show was up, vendor income was down. This is a general trend in all shows. Orchid prices are rising due to increased fuel and shipping costs.

Constance Anglin asked why as a member she received a show postcard in the mail. This was an error and not widespread.

Natalie Auburn made a motion to close the business meeting, Jeanne Kaeding seconded, the motion carried and the business meeting closed at 7:36 pm.

Carol Butcher called the group's attention to several recent articles in the AOS magazine, particularly this month's cover article on making an effective display, even with only a few plants.

Carol then introduced our speaker, Wendy Mazuk, who gave a fascinating presentation on ghost orchids. Wendy also had some photographs of ghost orchids for sale. Wendy also talked up several places

consist of 118 species native to Mexico, Central America, Colombia, Ecuador and Peru. The name *Dracula* literally means "little dragon", an allusion to the mythical Count Dracula, a lead character in numerous vampire novels and films. The name was applied to the orchid because of the blood-red color of several of the species, the strange aspect of the long spurs of the sepals. - Wikipedia

<p>¹I have only seen this sold as Burrageara (Cochlioda x Miltonia x Odontoglossum x Oncidium), but RHS (The Royal Horticultural Society) gives Kunthara (Cochlioda x Miltoniopsis x Odontoglossum x Oncidium) as a synonym and doesn't list Burrageara as a synonym at all. Cochlioda (Cda.) and Odontoglossum (Odm.) are now both folded into Oncidium.</p> <p>²Vuylstekeara was Cochlioda x Miltonia x Odontoglossum. Cochlioda and Odontoglossum are now Oncidium, and the Miltonia (Milt.) vexillaria ancestor is now Miltoniopsis (Mps.) vexillaria - hence Oncidopsis.</p> <p>³Hybridized and registered by our own Jeanne Kaeding.</p> <p>⁴Chiloschista nakornpanomensis appears on many vendor lists from all over the world. All agree it is native to Thailand. However, it does not appear on any official taxonomic lists. Apparently there has not been the requisite scientific publication of this species. However, I think the show table plant may have been mislabeled because every source shows nakornpanomensis has yellow flowers. I have not found any mention of an alba form.</p> <p>⁵Sorry, this is not violaceum. Maybe a hybrid with violaceum in the mix.
