



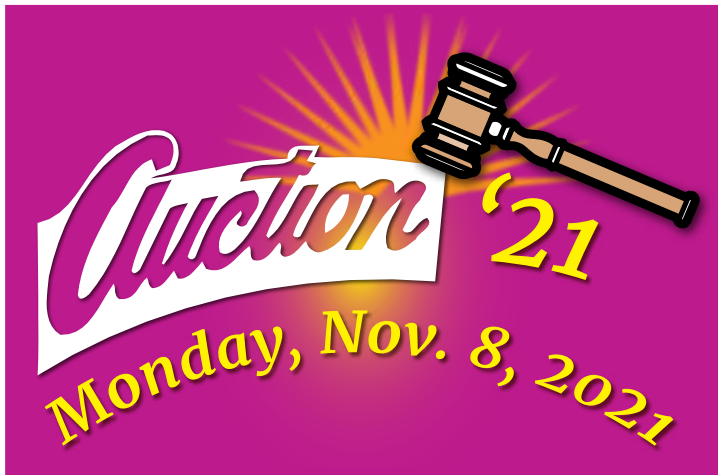

In-person Meeting: JCC Current Policies Updated 8/19/21

- If you are not vaccinated, you must wear a mask at all times. This includes children ages 2-12. Mask does not need to be worn in the pool.
- Mask-wearing is strongly encouraged throughout our facility even if you are vaccinated.
- Our staff are wearing masks.
- If you aren't feeling well, please stay home.
- We follow Monroe County Department of Health and CDC recommendations.
- If we are informed that a member or a staff has tested positive, we will contact trace within the JCC for exposure, defined by the CDC as 15 cumulative minutes spent within six feet of someone who is COVID-19 positive. We will notify anyone that is identified as having a possible exposure.
- Please note: The GROS will have its meeting in the large auditorium - with plenty of room for good social distancing.

We opened the doors at 6:00 for sales from LittleFrog Farm.

<p>Corrections are in bold. Correct genus abbreviation in parentheses after first appearance. All spellings per RHS. 'RHS' = Royal Horticultural Society (official hybrid registrar)</p> <p>RHS does NOT register forms, only by genus and species. Anywhere a plant is labeled 'coerulea' or 'fma coerulea' or 'alba' or 'fma alba' etc. that part of the information is omitted from the RHS registry.</p> <p>Accordingly, I have only included the form names as horticultural identifiers.</p> <p>¹This cross is sold by many vendors erroneously labeled "Cattleya Heathii" but C. Heathii (1) is actually harrisoniana x walkeriana. There is a natural hybrid of loddigesii x walkeriana called x dolosa, but per Julian Shaw of RHS, due to changes in naming rules, the man-made hybrid is not called Cattleya Dolosa. Also note Heathii (1) is distinguished from Heathii (2) which was previously a Sophrocattleya</p> <p>²Jeanne Kaeding is the hybridizer, not just the exhibitor.</p>
